The Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to comment on the proposed Notice of Construction Order No. 10371 and associated State Environmental Protection Act (SEPA) determination of non-significance (DNS) for Weyerhaeuser's Longview Lumber manufacturing facility.

## NOC Order

Weyerhaeuser owns and operates a dimensional lumber planer line, Planer #19, at the Longview Lumber manufacturing facility. The planer line includes a spray booth that applies an anti-fungal chemical to the surface of green, unplanned lumber. This inhibits the growth of blue sapstain mold and other fungi that would otherwise discolor and degrade the value of the finished lumber product.

The current chemical used contains volatile organic compounds (VOCs), pollutants under the Clean Air Act. The current VOC emission limit for Planer #19 is 12 tons/year.

In response to customer demands, Weyerhaeuser requested a change to the application rate of anti-fungal spray and VOC permit limit at Planer #19. This order allows an increase in the:

- Application rate of anti-fungal spray.
- VOC permit limit to 31.9 tons/year.

When the comment period ends, Ecology will review and consider all comments received and make appropriate changes to the order before issuing it.

**Facility description**

The Longview Lumber manufacturing facility is located at 3401 Industrial Way in Longview, on the Weyerhaeuser, Longview mill site. Since 2011, average production from the facility is 167 million board feet each year.

The mill site also includes a Kraft pulp mill, liquid packaging paper machine, extruder operation, saw mill, lumber drying kiln, log yard and log export operations, solid waste material recovery and transfer facility, log truck shop, and a thermo-mechanical/de-ink/newsprint mill (NORPAC) operated jointly with Nippon Paper Industries.
