If your vessel experiences any of the following, please submit this report to the Department of Ecology or fax it using Ecology's toll free fax number 1-800-664-9184 or 360-407-7288.

- Any abnormality or malfunction of steering, navigation, propulsion or safety systems;
- Breach of a cargo, bunker, bilge or ballast tank that causes or may reasonably be expected to cause an oil spill or loss of stability;
- Damage from a fire or explosion;
- Incomplete engineering or deck complement; or
- Any condition that could adversely affect the safety of a vessel, bridge, structure, shore area, or the environment.
